GENERAL INFORMATION

- All workshops at Sloan Museum include museum admission. Leaders may want to schedule time to explore the museum on their own after their workshop.
- In order to ensure a quality experience for all participants, we request that no siblings or infants accompany the participant.
- Space is limited. Registration is based on first-come, first served.
- Fees are due at least 2 weeks prior to the event date, however some dates fill up quickly. Early registration is recommended.
- Fees are non-refundable.
- A small snack will be provided during the workshops. Evening snack and breakfast are provided during the camp-ins.
- All workshop/camp-in participants receive a certificate of completion. Leaders are responsible for obtaining the actual award from their local council office.
- Workshops are \$9.00 per person, camp-ins are \$25.00 per scout and \$10.00 per adult chaperone. Fun nights are \$15 per scout and \$6 per adult chaperone.

Wonders of Water Journeys
